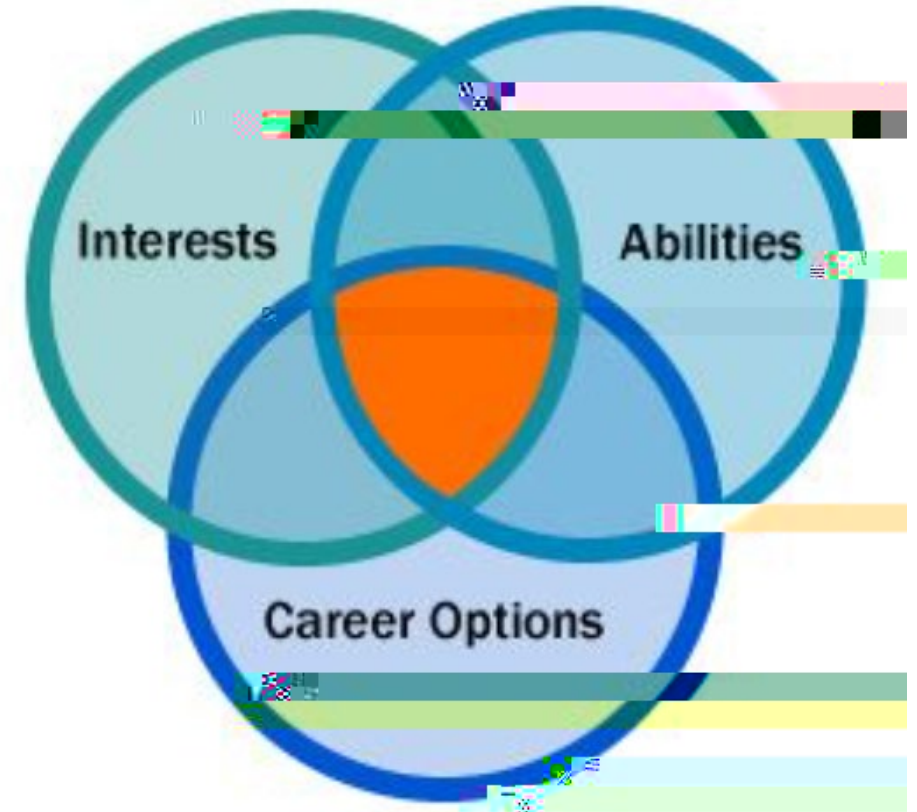

Individual Classes

A class typically lasting a few sessions to help the student gain skills required for a specific job. Examples range from computer based to hands on. Some examples include OSHA 10, CPR, First Aid and SERV Safe.

Short-Term Trainings which lead to Licensure

Career-focused classes which lead to licensure. Examples include LNA, EMT, Cosmetology, and CDL. These are intensive programs which require a combination of classroom and hands-on training.

Certificate Programs

A certificate program is a group of related courses designed to provide students with entry-level workplace skills in a particular field. Examples include Phlebotomy, Massage Therapy, Medical Billing and Coding, and Clinical Medical Assisting.





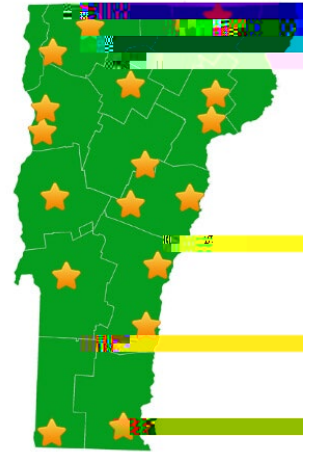

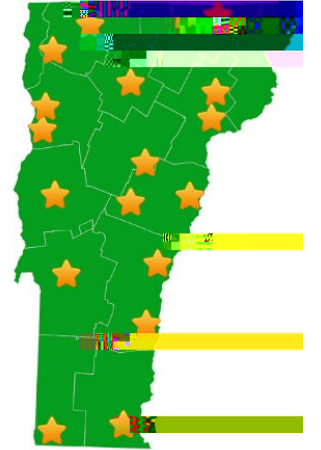
