

## What is StudentAid.gov?

The StudentAid.gov (formerly "FAFSA") is a unique username and password you create and use to log into your Federal Student Aid account to fill out the FAFSA form, and more.

The FAFSA stands for Free Application for Federal Student Aid. This form is always FREE to complete. Colleges and universities use the FAFSA information to determine what gift aid (grants and scholarships) a student is eligible for. If a student does not fill out the FAFSA, they will not be offered any federal financial aid and may experience delays with institutional aid. The student and contributor(s) will need to create a unique StudentAid.gov to complete the FAFSA.
